## NAU Homecoming Parade:

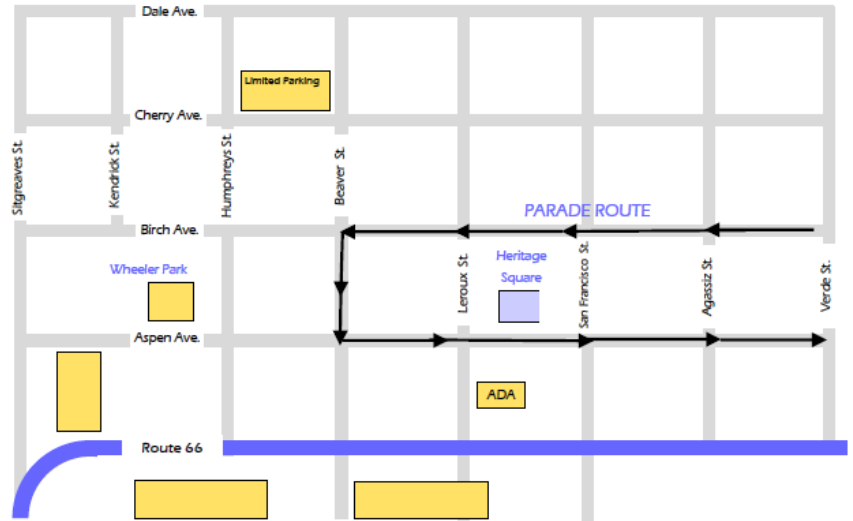
Saturday, October 25th

## Mountain Line Temporary Bus Stops:

- 3 buses will be assigned to assist Homecoming go-er's providing 10-15 minute service depending upon traffic and passenger loads
- Service will start at 6:15 AM and end at 12:00 noon
- Temporary Bus stop on Leroux and Route 66 (in front of Collins) – Normal RT10 service stops on Campus spine, Campus and Woodlands. (Buses will begin service at Leroux/66, Gillenwater Hall, and True North Dentistry/ University Dr at 6:15 AM)

# Sign Code Amendments Public Hearing

The City's Sign Standards are being simplified, improved and updated!

This is what is changing:

- No more confusing and duplicative standards
- More flexibility to place building mounted signs
- Increased height and area for freestanding signs
- More creative options for signs for multi-family residential uses
- Incentives for nonconforming signs
- Temporary signs may only be used for seasonal sales and promotions - no more "permanent" temporary signs
- Special considerations for the Downtown Historic District are proposed
- Better options for civic and non-profit event signs.
